- Based on the value of the positive outcome and cost of negative outcome, environments can be arranged in a 2-dimensional space
- The four corners of the 2-dimensional space define four different types of environments
- INFORMATION SECURITY is assumed to fall under “conservative in making errors” category

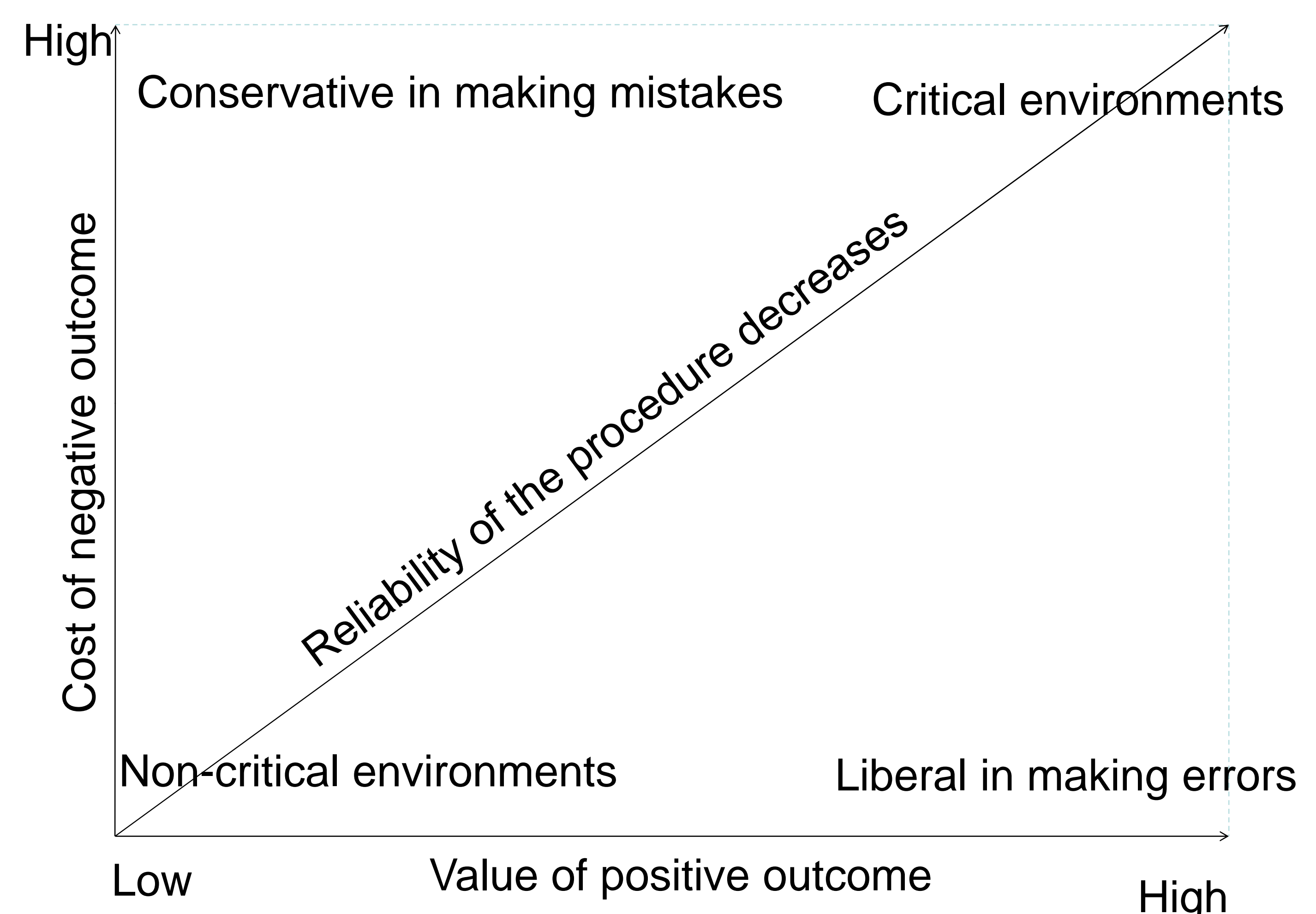


Figure 1. 2- Dimensional Space
